Please review the following **COVID-19** guidelines;

Non-credit Classroom & Lab Use during COVID-19

Thank-you for choosing to take noncredit classes at Southeast Community College (SCC). We are committed to the safety of our community.

For the well-being of all, SCC is taking precautions and asking students, instructors, and staff to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Based on recommendations by local public health officials and the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the following guidelines will be updated as often as necessary as this unprecedented situation evolves.

- **Distancing:** Six feet or more of physical distance is recommended between everyone at all times, including in the classroom or lab, during both class time and breaks. SCC will arrange rooms to help maintain proper distancing, reduce class sizes, or relocate classes to a larger room when possible.
- **Face Covering/Shields:** Face coverings are required in all College facilities, including classrooms and labs, even when six feet of distance can be maintained. Students are required to bring their own face covering and to wear it properly, covering both nose and mouth. (Exception: CDC and local public health do not recommend masks with exhalation valves or vents.) Please request a disposable face mask from your instructor or the front desk if you forget to bring your own. The removal of face coverings should be limited to unique situations such as outdoor breaks where six feet of distance can be maintained.
- **Cleaning:** Cleaning supplies will be provided in each classroom for student use. Students will be asked to clean their learning space prior to being seated. Hand sanitation stations are readily available throughout the building and in classrooms. Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer is recommended.
- **Food/Drinks:** Food consumption is allowed in the building if six feet or more of physical distance can be maintained. Students can bring their own food or drinks, but refrigeration will not be available. Bringing food to share with a group is prohibited.
- **Health:** If you or people you live with are sick or exhibiting symptoms of the illness, please do not come to class and notify the Continuing Education staff at 402-437-2700 that you will be absent.

We appreciate your cooperation while learning in a shared space.
